
LANGUAGE BRIDGES

The classes available are for different levels of proficiency: Basic, False Beginner, Intermediate and Advanced.

The learners have explored cultural nuances, etiquette, historical backgrounds, personal challenges, and communication styles, enabling them to engage in conversations more with trust and confidence.
